

Pancyprrian Photography Competition

Scientific evidence demonstrates the direct relationship between human health (good physical and mental state) and the environment, including lifestyle and individual behaviors. Human health is significantly affected by climate change, environmental degradation and pollution, which increases the risk of developing chronic diseases, such as cancer, cardiovascular disease and diabetes. On the other hand, healthy environments (e.g. clean air, clean water and green cities) could promote a healthier lifestyle and prevent/reduce disease, overall. Healthy and sustainable lifestyles and choices should be considered a priority for the health of the planet and that of future generations.

Accordingly, the **Cyprus International Institute for Environmental and Public Health (CII)** of the **Cyprus University of Technology (CUT)**, in cooperation with the **Cyprus Photographic Society, Limassol Branch**, organize a Pancyprrian Photography Competition entitled:

« The Impact of the Environment on Public Health »

The competition is **open to all photographers**, both amateurs and professionals. Participants are asked to showcase the positive or/and negative impact of the environment on public health with up to 10 pictures, maximum. With the enrollment in the competition you agree to accept the following terms and conditions.

The purpose of the contest is to raise awareness amongst the Cypriot citizens and stimulate their interest in understanding the connection between the environment and human health. It will allow them to adopt healthier lifestyles and thus, reduce the risk and/or prevent the development of chronic diseases.

Pancyprian Photography Competition

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The entrant should be the creator and owner of the submitted pictures and be responsible for the persons that are depicted in them. By submitting an entry, the photographer states that the pictures and the process of making them do not break the law nor infringe rights of third parties.**
- 2. About the submission of photographs:**
 - 2.1** Participants may submit **up to 10 colour digital photographs**. The pictures need to be submitted on a CD (**JPG format**) with a clearly written **(1)** 5-digit photographer's password (**defined by the participant**) and **(2)** the title of the competition («The Impact of the Environment on Public Health»).
 - 2.2** Each digital picture on the CD should bear the 5-digit password, its' serial number and title. The title of the archive should only be written in Latin characters. For example, the third picture entitled "**environment**" of the entrant having the **password 22555** should be: **22555-3-environment**. Furthermore, the titles should be small and comprehensive.
 - The picture titles can be completed either in Greek or in English on the application form.
 - **NOTE: "untitled" submissions or a title which is repeated on multiple or all pictures, or/and without a serial number (i.e. "environment-1", "environment-2", etc.) will automatically be rejected. Furthermore, the titles should be small and comprehensive.**
 - **NOTE: Pictures with any kind of mark, such as watermark, initials, dates, symbols etc will automatically be rejected.**
 - 2.3** Participation in the competition is **free of charge**.
 - 2.4** Each entrant should deliver his/her **(1)** duly completed participation form and **(2)** the CD with the pictures in a sealed envelope to the **Cyprus Photographic Society (Limassol Branch)**, 120 Angyras Street, 1st floor, every Wednesday and Saturday from 4pm to 8pm. (Tel: 25384381).
 - 2.5** The last date for submission is **Saturday 30th March 2019**, no exceptions. Submissions can be delivered to the **Cyprus Photographic Society (Limassol Branch)**, 120 Angyras Street, 1st floor, every Wednesday and Saturday, from 4.00pm to 8.00pm. (Tel: 25384381).
 - 2.6 *Photographs which have been previously or simultaneously submitted in other photographic competitions, or are uploaded on any social media platform are not eligible for this contest.***
 - 2.7** The Judging Committee consists of independent photographers, other artists, and the representatives of the organisers of the contest. The judges' decision is final, irreversible, and cannot be influenced*.
 - ***The organisers and/or judges retain the right, during the judging procedure, not to give an award and/or honourable mention if they consider that the submitted pictures do not meet the present terms and conditions or if they do not come up to the standard of this competition.***
 - 2.8** After the judging procedure, all corresponding photographers of the selected pictures will be informed accordingly in order to print the pictures for exhibition. The printed pictures will need to be delivered to the Cyprus Photographic Society, Limassol Branch. Per photographer a maximum of 6 pictures can be selected.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (continued)

Panoramic or squared pictures should be printed on photographic paper (of a size that will be requested by the organisers), leaving the surrounding space either white or black.

2.9 The **Organisers** have the right to use any submitted pictures on websites or other platforms, but are obligated to mention the photographer.

2.10 The **Organisers** will keep an electronic archive with all entries, as well as an archive with the awarded (printed) pictures.

2.11 The rest of the printed of photographs will be returned to their owners, following completion of the exhibition.

2.12 The **Organizers** will put an effort not to lose or damage any photograph. However, the **Organisers** are not responsible, nor accountable for any loss or damage of CD's and/or pictures.

3. Awards & exhibition:

3.1 There will be awarded **three (3) partial scholarships based on academic merit** to attend the new Master's programme in Public Health (MPH). The programme and academic criteria of admission are described at:

- **NOTE: Participants of the competition who wish to be considered for partial scholarship will *also* need to need to apply for a place in the MPH programme through the above link.** A partial scholarship would only be awarded to the successful participant / applicant and it cannot be transferred to others. Successful participants / applicants will need to be available to receive the scholarship for commencing the programme in the next academic year 2019-2020, at the latest.
